

Vaping Alert

There have been several reports of sudden onset of acute respiratory distress syndrome brought on by vaping. State and federal health authorities, including the CDC, believe contaminants or counterfeit substances are the likely cause of this vaping-related lung illnesses — now up to 354 possible cases in 29 states.

These instances appear to have involved illegal street purchases, often in open cartridges that might contain a contaminant or other drug. To date there have not been any cases involving regulated products.

Health authorities are warning the public to only purchase products being sold at official, approved and regulated medical marijuana dispensaries as they sell closed cartridges where there is no risk of contamination or the presence of unknown drugs.
